RESOLUTION NO. R

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PIGGYBACK CONTRACT AWARDED BY THE CITY OF DEERFIELD BEACH, FLORIDA (CONTRACT ITB 25-016) TO SHRIEVE CHEMICAL COMPANY, LLC. & INTERACID NORTH AMERICA, INC. FOR SULFURIC ACID 93% FOR WATER TREATMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Davie Utilities Department requires a vendor for sulfuric acid 93% for water treatment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Deerfield Beach, Florida competitively solicited for these services and awarded contract ITB 25-016 to Shrieve Chemical Company, LLC (as primary vendor) and Interacid North America, Inc. (as secondary vendor); and

WHEREAS, after reviewing, the Town council authorizes the Town to piggyback the contract awarded by City of Deerfield Beach (Contract No. ITB 25-017) for Sulfuric Acid 93% for water treatment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. Legislative Findings/Recitals. The above recitals are hereby adopted by the Town of Davie as its legislative findings relative to the subjects and matters set forth in this Resolution.

Section 2. Shrieve Chemical Company, LLC is the primary vendor but cannot fulfill the requests from Town at this time. Once Shrieve Chemical Company, LLC commits to fulfilling Town requests, the Council hereby grants authority to the Town Administrator to execute a cooperative/ piggyback agreement.

Section 3. As stated in the Contract, in the event the Primary Contractor cannot fulfill the request from the Town, the Town reserves the right to utilize the Secondary Contractor in its sole discretion. Therefore, the Town Council of the Town of Davie does hereby accept the piggyback agreement with Interacid North America, Inc. as secondary vendor for Sulfuric Acid 93% for Water Treatment.

Section 4. The Town Council hereby authorizes expenditures of funds over \$65,000 per year in accordance with the awarded contract prices, on an as-needed basis. Funding will come from approved accounts, dependent on usage and within established budgets.

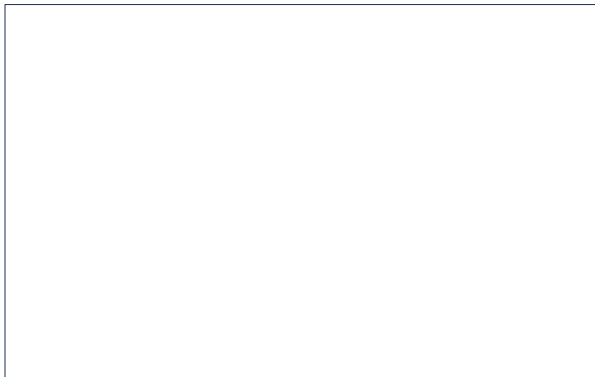
Section 5. The contract term is effective through July 16, 2028, with the option to renew for three (3) additional one (1)-year periods. Contract renewals, extensions, termination, and amendments/modifications will be handled administratively.

Section 6. Conflict. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 7. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, it is the intent of the Town Council that such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and, to this end, the provisions of this Resolution are declared severable.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
