



Proclamation

WHEREAS, public works professionals focus on facilities, infrastructure and services that are of vital importance to sustainable and resilient communities and to the public health, high quality of life, and well-being of the people of the Town of Davie; and

WHEREAS, these facilities, infrastructure, and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals, who are engineers, managers and employees from state and local governments and the private sector, who are responsible for rebuilding, improving, and protecting our nation's transportation, stormwater, public buildings, landscaping, and other structures and facilities essential for our citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the citizens, civic leaders and children in the Town of Davie to gain knowledge of and to maintain a progressive interest and understanding of the importance of public works and public works programs in the respective communities; and

WHEREAS, the American Public Works Association has celebrated the annual National Public Works Week since 1960; and

WHEREAS, this year's theme "Rooted in Service, Powered by Community," acknowledges that the roots of service run deep in public works. It's what has propelled public works innovations that have helped our communities evolve into places where people can lead lives of purpose and possibility.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Mayor and the Town Council of the Town of Davie do hereby proclaim the week of May 17 – 23, 2026 as:
