RESOLUTION NO. R

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PIGGYBACK CONTRACT AWARDED BY THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA (CONTRACT NO. 23-45-09-VH) TO AQUIFER MAINTENANCE AND PERFORMANCE SYSTEMS, INC. (AMPS) AND A.C. SCHULTES OF FLORIDA, INC. FOR ANNUAL WELLFIELD MAINTENANCE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Davie Utilities Department requires a vendor for annual wellfield maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunrise, Florida competitively solicited a bid for these services and awarded contract #23-45-09-VH to AMPS, Inc. and A.C. Schultes of Florida, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the Town Council authorizes the Town to piggyback the contract awarded by the City of Sunrise Contract No.23-45-09-VH for annual wellfield maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. Legislative Findings/Recitals. The above recitals are hereby adopted by the Town of Davie as its legislative findings relative to the subjects and matters set forth in this Resolution.

Section 2. The Town Council of the Town of Davie does hereby accept the piggyback contract PB-JA-26-28 awarded for Annual Wellfield Maintenance solicited through City of Sunrise Contract No. 23-45-09-VH.

Section 3. The Town Council hereby authorizes expenditures of funds over \$65,000 per year in accordance with the awarded contract prices, on an as-needed basis. Funding will come from approved accounts, dependent on usage and within established budgets.

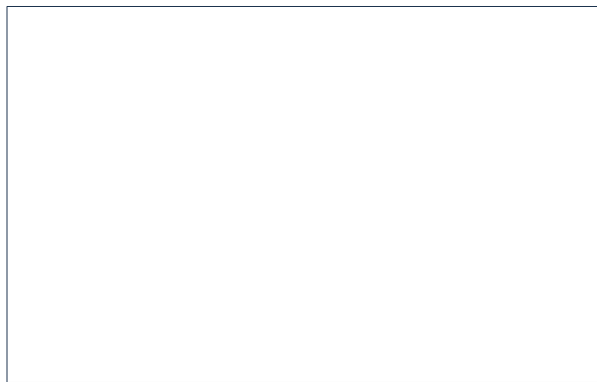
Section 4. The contract term is effective through February 11, 2027, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one (1)-year periods. Contract renewals, extensions, termination, and amendments/modifications will be handled administratively.

Section 5. Conflict. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, it is the intent of the Town Council that such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and, to this end, the provisions of this Resolution are declared severable.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
