**RESOLUTION NO. R 2026**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING GRANT AGREEMENT #BW846 FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IN BROWARD COUNTY (DOH-BROWARD) FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTINUED SUPPORT FOR THE OVERDOSE AND POST-OVERDOSE CO-RESPONDER MODEL TO PROVIDE HARM REDUCTION SERVICES AND LINKAGE TO CARE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Davie Fire Rescue Department was awarded the initial grant funding by DOH-Broward for the purpose of developing and implementing a Co-Responder overdose and post-overdose model via Resolution 2025-060;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Co-Responder overdose and post-overdose model is to provide harm reduction services, linkage to care, and social support services for individuals involved in substance-related emergencies;

WHEREAS, DOH-Broward has awarded the Town of Davie Fire Rescue funds under grant agreement #BW846 for the continuation and support of the Co-Responder overdose post-overdose model;

WHEREAS, the continuation of this model will be at no additional cost to the Town;

WHEREAS, this is a fixed price, fixed fee contract;

WHEREAS, for the grant periods May 2026 through April 2027 and May 2027 through April 2028, there will be equal monthly payments in the amount of \$12,321.00 for a total dollar amount not to exceed \$147,852.00 in each contract year;

WHEREAS, for the grant period May 2028 through August 2028, there will be equal monthly payments of \$12,321.00 for a total dollar amount not to exceed \$49,284.00 for the contract period; and

WHEREAS, DOH-Broward has agreed to pay the Town of Davie Fire Rescue Department a total dollar amount not to exceed \$344,988.00 for the contract term of May 2026 through August 2028.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. Legislative Findings/Recitals. The above recitals are hereby adopted by

the Town Council of the Town of Davie as its legislative findings relative to the subjects and matters set forth in this Resolution.

Section 2. The Town Council of the Town of Davie hereby approves the grant from the Florida Department of Health in Broward County (DOH-Broward) Agreement #BW846 and authorizes the Mayor to execute the Agreement in the amount of \$344,988.00 over the contract term of May 2026 through August 2028.

Section 3. The grant disbursement period will occur May 2026 through April 2027 and May 2027 through April 2028, with equal monthly reimbursable payments in the amount of \$12,321.00 for a total dollar amount not to exceed \$147,852.00 in each contract year. The grant period of May 2028 through August 2028, there will be equal monthly payments of \$12,321.00 for a total dollar amount not to exceed \$49,284.00 for the contract period.

Section 4. The Town Council authorizes the Director of Budget and Finance to recognize grant revenues and expenditures and appropriate according to the grant agreement.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, it is the intent of the Town Council that such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and, to this end, the provisions of this Resolution are declared severable.

Section 6. Conflicts. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
