RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA, EXECUTING AN ADDENDUM TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF DAVIE AND SUNSHINE NURSING CARE, PLLC TO SATISFY A GRANT REQUIREMENT FOR THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IN BROWARD COUNTY CORESPONDER (CoRe) PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTINUED SUPPORT FOR THE OVERDOSE AND POST-OVERDOSE CO-RESPONDER MODEL TO PROVIDE HARM REDUCTION SERVICES AND LINKAGE TO CARE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council, on September 4, 2024, passed Resolution 2024-181 executing the agreement between the Town of Davie and Sunshine Nursing Care, PLLC to continue providing professional services for the Town of Davie Fire Rescue Department's community care provider program and related health services;

WHEREAS, the term of the agreement began on September 7, 2024, through September 30, 2025, unless otherwise terminated pursuant to the terms of the Agreement. Thereafter, the Agreement is automatically renewable on October 1st from year to year for a twelve (12) month period. Contract renewals, extensions, termination, and amendments/modifications will be handled administratively;

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Health in Broward County (DOH-Broward) grant opportunity is for co-responder overdose and post-overdose funding for the Town to provide community harm reduction services, linkage to care, and social support services for individuals involved in substance-related emergencies;

WHEREAS, the Town applied for and received a 28-month grant which spans from May 2026 through August 2028 in the amount of \$344,988 and payments will be \$12,321 equal monthly payments; and

WHEREAS, in order to satisfy the requirements for a grant, staff is respectfully requesting that the Town Council to authorize an addendum to the agreement to reflect additional specified services related to a Florida Department of Health in Broward County grant opportunity for the Post Overdose Co-Responder Program Model for Emergency Medical Services and to clarify the term of the grant agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAVIE, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. Legislative Findings/Recitals. The above recitals are hereby adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Davie as its legislative findings relative to the subjects and matters set forth in this Resolution.

Section 2. The Town Council approves the amended terms as related to the Florida Department of Health in Broward County co-responder overdose and post-overdose grant agreement.

Section 3. The Town Council authorizes the Director of Budget and Finance to recognize grant revenues and appropriate according to the grant agreement.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, it is the intent of the Town Council that such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and, to this end, the provisions of this Resolution are declared severable.

Section 5. Conflicts. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
